## 1. Charles Heidsieck Brut Reserve £49.00

From one of the most admired houses; its legacy originating in 1851 and soon became known as 'Champagne Charlie' Pale gold, persistent bubbles giving a silky smooth sensation, a perfect balance of freshness and generosity

## 2. Baron Fuente Brut Grande Reserve NV £39.00

Family owned, this delicious champagne is made with the classic grape varieties creating a fresh, lively and elegant wine.

## 3. De Castelnau Rose NV £49.00

Salmon pink in colour with the scent of summer cherries and strawberry, this Champagne has a roundness, elegance and Zesty finish rarely equalled

# THE WHITE WINES

Europe

## 6. Mezzora Pinot Grigio Garganega 2016 £18.00

Produced from grapes grown in the beautiful hills north of Verona, flavours of pears and summer peaches, gives dry, fresh and stylish wine

## 7. Picpoul 2016 'Baron de Badassiere' £18.50

Warm sunny vineyards situated near the coast in the South of France make the fresh and zippy wine. Pale lemon in colour with crisp apples and citrus on the nose, the flavour – ripe yellow plum, greengage fruit and fresh lemon acidity, delicious

## 8. Cune Monopole 'Dry White' 2016 £18.50

This crisp and fresh dry white Rioja is made entirely from the white Viura grape. It has aromas of ripe citrus fruit and is the perfect partner for fish and seafood, or on its own any time

## 9. Coleridge Hill 2016 'Three Choirs Vineyard' £19.50

Three Choirs is one of England's best known single estates. Producing wines since 1975 this crisp dry white is a great example, in fact the perfect aperitif; it has the aromas of wild elderflower and nettle with a clean fresh and lasting finish

## 10. Macon Blanc lugny 2016 'Les Charmes' £23.50

This wine is produced in the heart of Burgundy from the Chardonnay grapes grown in the limestone hills near Macon, fresh full flavoured with a lingering finish

**11. Gavi di Gavi ' Vigneti Lugarara' 2016** **£27.00**

This top estate covers 30 hectares in the heart of Piemonte. The wines are of the best quality – the Cortese grapes are gently pressed, they see no oak thus creating a wine that has a great concentration of flavours and balanced acidity, and this is certainly one of the best that Italy produces

**12. Sancerre 2016 Clos des Bouffants** **£27.00**

Dry, fresh and well balanced, this full flavoured attractive wine is a constant favourite – a superb compliment to any fish dish

**13. Pouilly Fuisse 2015/16 Pascal Clement** **£32.50**

Coming from the most prestigious and famous vineyard of Macon; hazelnut and grilled almonds on the nose and a creamy peach fruit on the palate, an elegant wine drinking beautifully now

New World

**14. Anuela Sauvignon Blanc 2016 'Casablanca Valley'** **£18.00**

Just a few miles from the Pacific Ocean the Casablanca Valley produces some of the very best Chilean Sauvignon. The intense aromas of fresh, herb and apple, together with the flavour of exotic fruits and ripe pineapple make this smooth, lively and distinctive zesty wine

**15. Fair Trade Chenin Blanc 2017 Liberty** **£18.00**

The grapes for this Fair Trade wine are grown on three farms just a two hour drive from Cape Town. Pale straw in colour, the nose it has the perfumes of fresh crisp apples and a hint of pineapple, the flavour is of tropical fruit yet crisp, clean and dry on the finish

**16. Bonnaburra Chardonnay 2016** **£18.00**

This fully flavoured yet soft and elegant Australian white is pale straw in colour with the aroma of peaches and apricots

**17. ESK Valley Black Label Pinot Gris ' Hawked Bay' 2016** **£22.00**

From New Zealand's North Island this rich, full-bodied wine bursts with the aromas of ripe pears with hints of pineapple, and on the palate it is rich and satisfying – testimony to the excellent fruit used in its production

**18. Runnumede Island Sauvignon 2016 ' Marlborough'** **£22.00**

Bursting with green fruit flavours and a herbaceous twist this delicious thirst quenching Sauvignon is what New Zealand does best

## ROSE

**19. Rioja El Coto 2016 Rose** **£18.00**

Enjoy those summer days with this soft, easy drinking rose the flavour of strawberries and wild fruits, Northern Spain at its best!

**20. Cuvee Nuit Blanche Rose 2016 Chateau L'Arnaude** **£22.00**

Modern and stylish, this attractive rose is classic 'Provence', pale salmon in colour with flavours of summer berries and wild strawberry with just a touch of lemon zest, delicious.

# AND THE REDS

Europe

**21. Larchago Tempranillo Joven 2015 Rioja** **£18.00**

Beautiful purple in colour reflecting its youth, aromas of dark fruit and strawberry and a hint of black liquorice, smooth, silky and fruity, enjoy cool

**22. Cotes du Rhone 2016 'Les Terres du Roy'** **£18.50**

From the 'Land of the Kings' this easy drinking Rhone wine is full of black and red berried fruit. Rich yet subtle well balanced, delightful to drink now.

**23. Chateau de Moulin de Mallet 2015 AC Bordeaux** **£18.50**

Family owned since 1898 this property sits overlooking the Dordogne valley and the slopes of St Emilion. The perfume and flavour of ripe red and black fruits together with soft tannis from the high proportion of Merlot in the blend make this truly pleasurable easy to drink red Bordeaux

**24. Primitivo di Manduria 2014 Puglia** **£20.00**

From family producer Paolo Leo's mature vineyards situated in Salento southern Ital. These native grapes are hand selected and picked, the result a wine that is intense ruby in colour with the aromas of wild berries and ripe cherry, full bodied with an intense fruit flavour and a gentle spicy finish from its time in small oak casks, exceptional quality

**25. Quinta Do Crasto 'Douro' 2015** **£20.00**

From the banks of the river Douro, this family property has made wine since 1910. Deep red in colour it has intense berry fruit and a little subtle oak on the nose yet with a rich concentrated flavour. Originally these wines would have been sold to the famous port houses; today they show that the red wines of Portugal are ready to be enjoyed anytime.

**26. Rioja El Coto de Imaz Reserva 2011/12** **£24.00**

A stunning quality wine from one of the best bodegas. Incredible fruit, good structure, this is one of the very best

**27. Chateau Caillou Les Martins Lussac St Emilion 2011/12** **£24.00**

A small family owned house makes this very good Bordeaux. Deep garnet red in colour with purple tints, the aromas and flavours of ripe blackcurrant and berry fruit with a touch of spice, together with well balanced velvety tannis. A good vintage, drinking now

**28. Fleurie 2016 Domaine de la Bouroniere** **£25.00**

One of the most popular of the ten individual Beaujolais villages, this medium bodied wine has an intense raspberry fruit flavour and delivers excellent quality try it slightly chilled

**29. Crozes Hermitage 2014/15 'Nicholas Perrin'** **£30.00**

Two of great families of the Rhone; Nicholas Jaboulet and the Perrin Family of Chateau de Beaucastel came together with the sole aim of producing top quality Northern Rhone Wines. This superb example has the fragrant aromas and flavour of soft black cherry, blackberries with a hint of smokiness. Intense well integrated tannins make this a fruity delicious wine

New World

**30. Septima Malbec 2015/16 Mendoza** **£18.50**

Intense violet in colour with the flavour of sweet fruits – plums, blackberries and quince, soft tannins with a flavour of vanilla from its time in oak. Top Malbec-what Argentina does best!

**31. Vonderling 'Baldrick' Shiraz 2015****£19.50**

Young Southwest facing vineyards planted in one of South Africa's best independent properties make this delicious blend of Mainly Shiraz, a hint of Mourvedre and a little Viognier. Clean, Pure red and black fruits abound with just a hint of oak and a little Spices on its smooth juicy lingering finish

**32. Caliterra Tributo Carmenere 2014/15 ' Colchagua Valley'****£20.00**

This wine is made from grapes specially selected lots on the Caliterra Estate, handpicked and gently crushed this wine was aged for 14 months in oak casks. Its intense aromatic flavour gives off notes of dried fruit, chocolate and hints of moist tobacco leaves. Its soft tannis deliver an excellent balance and long lasting finish

**33. Painted Wolf ' The Den' Pinotage 2014/15****£20.00**

A true 'smorgasbord' of red and black summer berries, hints of spice and vanilla from time in small oak casks. South Africa's famous native grape – well made

**34. Runnymede Island Pinot Noir 2015 ' Marlborough'****£22.00**

New Zealand makes some of the best pinot Noir, this new wine from a small family property on the South Island has the aromas and favours of ripe black cherry. Soft, silky and lasting, with a gentle spicy character – drink cool, even chilled.

## Dessert Wine

**35. Chateau de la Peyrade NV Muscat de Frontignan****£16.00 / half a bottle**

Family owned, this small 18th century Château sits on a hill between the sea and an inland lagoon. The delicious Muscat wine that it makes is deep golden in colour, with the intense aromas of lychee, honey and hints of orange. It is rich, full flavoured and delightfully sticky, a must to end your meal with!
